## application procedures for first-time freshmen

If you are a U.S. resident, complete this application for admission and forward it to the Grace College Admissions Office. A \$30 application fee must accompany your application, payable to Grace College (waived for online application).

### early action admission (non-binding)

Candidates who apply by December 1 will receive admission and preliminary scholarship notification within two weeks of application completion.

- Notification of decision . . . . .Two weeks
- Enrollment deposit due . . . . . May 1

### regular admission

Grace College has an application deadline of March 1.\* Candidates who apply after December 1 will receive admission and preliminary scholarship decision within two weeks of application completion.

- Application materials due . . . . . by March 1\*
- Notification of decision . . . . .Two weeks
- Enrollment deposit due . . . . . May 1

\* Applications received after March 1 are considered until the class is full.

### school reference & transcripts request (enclosed)

**All Grace College applicants** must submit official high school transcripts. Complete the top portion of the school reference and transcript request form and forward it to your high school guidance counselor. The counselor will complete the remainder of the form and return it along with a copy of your official high school transcripts directly to the Grace College Admissions Office.

**All applicants who have attended a post-secondary educational institution** must submit transcripts from each post-secondary institution attended (even if no credit was earned or grades received). Complete the top portion of the college transcripts request form and send it to each post-secondary institution that you have attended since high school. Make copies of the form as necessary. The registrar at each of those institutions will complete the remainder of the form and return it along with a copy of your official transcripts from that institution directly to the Grace College Admissions Office.

### ACT/SAT scores

**All first-year freshmen applicants** must submit an official copy of either ACT or SAT scores. An official copy of your scores may be obtained from your high school or by request from [www.act.org](http://www.act.org) or [www.sat.org](http://www.sat.org). The Grace College code numbers are 1198 for the ACT or 1252 for the SAT.

**Transfer applicants** must submit an official copy of either ACT or SAT scores if you have completed less than 15 hours of college coursework after graduating from high school. An official copy of your scores may be obtained from your high school or by request from [www.act.org](http://www.act.org) or [www.sat.org](http://www.sat.org). The Grace College code numbers are 1198 for the ACT or 1252 for the SAT.

### application evaluation

Once your completed application, school reference, transcripts, and ACT or SAT scores have been received in our Admissions Office, your application for admission to Grace College will be complete and will be evaluated by the Admissions Committee (Grace College reserves the right to request additional information if needed). - As a life can never be complete without fulfillment in Christ Jesus and His Word, neither is knowledge complete except as it relates to God's eternal values.
- An important aspect of student life at Grace College is corporate worship and fellowship. Therefore, regular attendance at chapel and Sunday services (in an evangelical church) is required of all full-time students.
- As part of Grace College's commitment to a distinctive lifestyle and experience, students are to refrain from the use of alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, tobacco, sexual misconduct, gambling, cheating, theft, coarse or obscene language, or any other conduct inconsistent with the goals and traditions of the college. Further, Grace College students are to abstain from morally degrading media and literature.
- It should be understood that any behavior which indicates that an enrolled student has little regard for living a life honoring to God, or whose conduct evidences a spirit of disregard for the college standards, will be sufficient reason for disciplinary action or dismissal.
