

Grace College's Office of Financial Aid awards federal financial aid in accordance with the most recent Title IV regulations (<https://ifap.ed.gov/ifap/>). The office staff receives training at least three times per year from Department of Education trainers.

Grace College's Office of Financial Aid awards state financial aid in accordance with IN, OH, RI and VT regulations. The office staff receives training from the state of Indiana trainers at least two times per year.

Grace College's Office of Financial Aid awards institutional financial aid per the institution's financial aid policies. Institutional aid is applied towards tuition only and may be applied towards room and board only after approval of senior administration and on a case-by-case basis. All institutional aid is determined by the Admissions office during the admissions process, except for athletic aid. Athletic aid is determined by the coach of the individual sport.

Grace College's Office of Financial Aid administers private/outside scholarships per the guidelines received from the outside entity and in accordance with federal regulations from the Department of Education.
