Grace College Department of Graduate Counseling is seeking applications for the position of Part-time Instructor of Counseling for our CACREP-accredited program's online service platform. Responsibilities include teaching online graduate counseling courses, supervision, mentoring, and collaboration with department faculty. All Part-time faculty must be available to attend a one week on-campus residency in August if requested. All Part-time faculty are expected to attend Department meetings regularly online.

Grace College is an evangelical Christian Liberal Arts College. Located in the resort community of Winona Lake (near Warsaw, Indiana 36 miles west of Ft. Wayne), Grace College offers 52 academic majors and 38 minors. Central to its mission is developing character, sharpening competence and preparing for service.

Our goal in Christian living and teaching is to make Christ preeminent in all things. The programs of the college, as well as its community lifestyle commitment, are designed to encourage serious academic inquiry, a biblical worldview, spiritual understanding, and social conscience, all in the context of God's grace.

The Graduate Counseling Department is housed within the School of Behavioral Sciences, which includes both undergraduate and graduate programs. The department's purpose is "to provide graduate level programming that equips students to be scripturally grounded, professionally skilled, and interpersonally competent as they actively engage in the counseling profession and its related ministries." The purpose of the CMHC degree is "to prepare students for future licensure in clinical mental health counseling." This department seeks counseling faculty Part-time members who hold views comparable to those of the institution, which include the institution's doctrinal commitments, called the Covenant of Faith. It also seeks Part-time faculty members who will complement the contributions of the department's existing faculty.

<u>Preferred Qualifications</u>: This position offers a challenging opportunity to Part-time instructors with teaching and clinical experience in the area of counseling. The successful candidate will have:

- 1. Ph.D. in Counselor Education and Supervision or be on track for completion by the date of hire.
- 2. License as a mental health/professional counselor in applicant's state of residency.
- 3. Minimum of two years of counseling experience.
- 4. Two years of successful teaching in higher education including experience in online teaching.
- 5. Strong interpersonal skills that engage students in educational, personal, and spiritual growth.
- 6. Strong commitment to teaching counseling skills from a biblical foundation
- 7. Commitment to the mission and values of an evangelical Christian institution which values the centrality of Jesus Christ and the Holy Scriptures in the purpose and life of the institution.
- 8. An appreciation for an academic program that encourages professional and spiritual growth among students and faculty.
