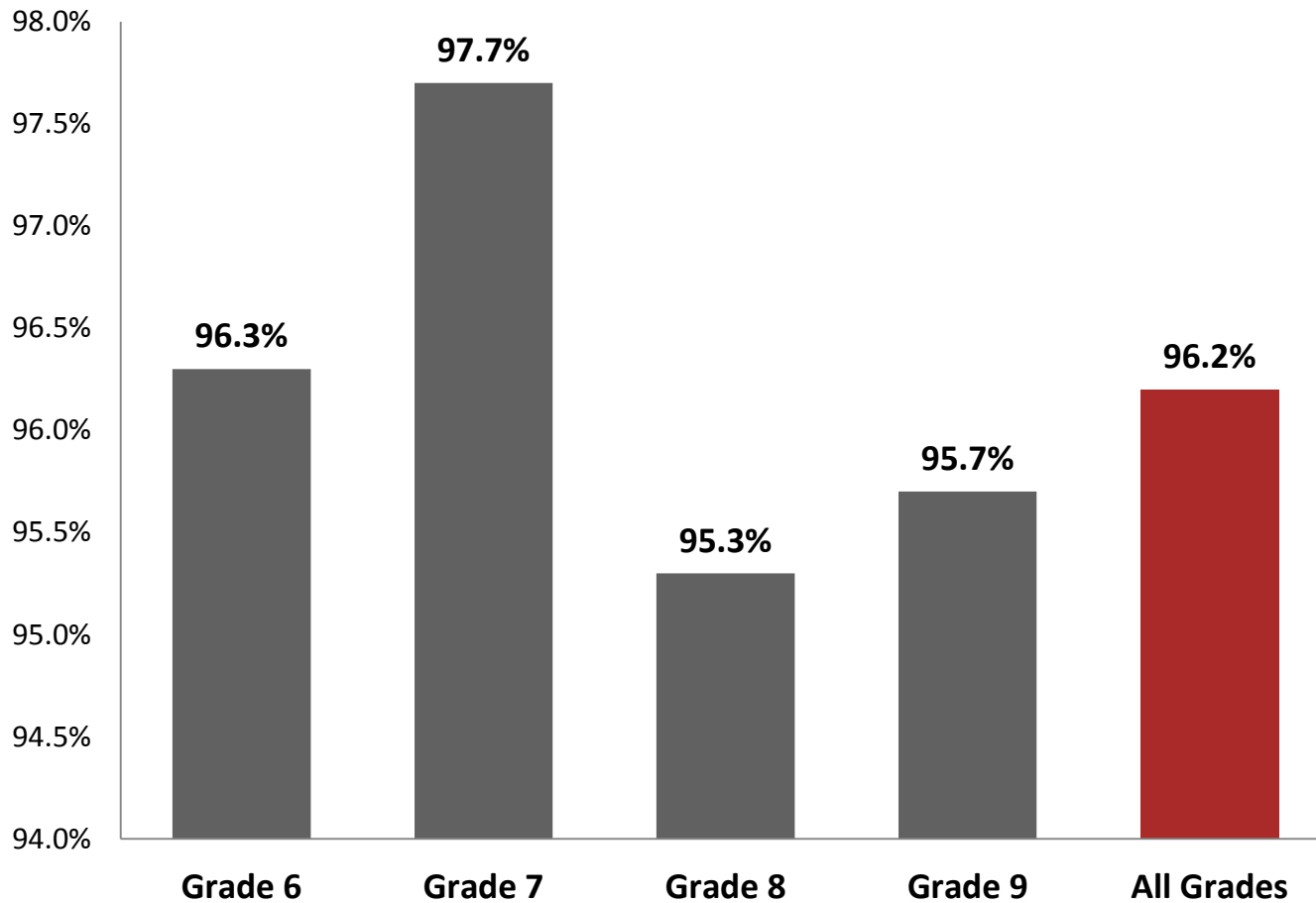

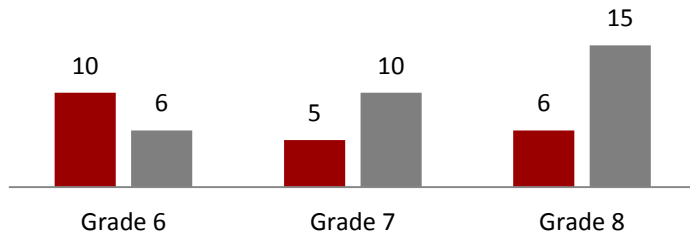

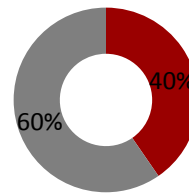
English Language Arts

English Language Arts All Students

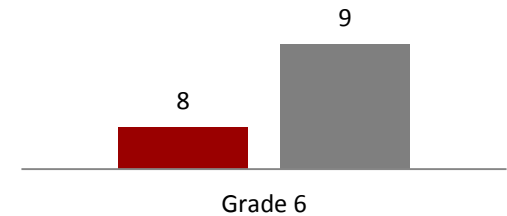

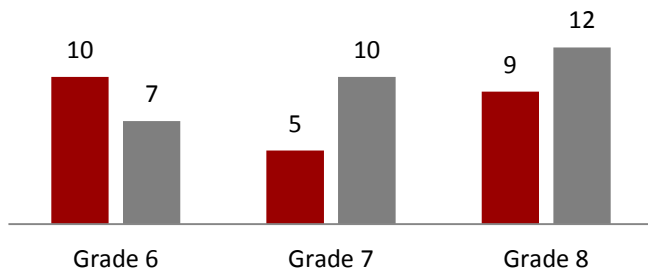

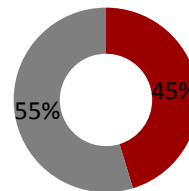
Mathematics

Mathematics All Students

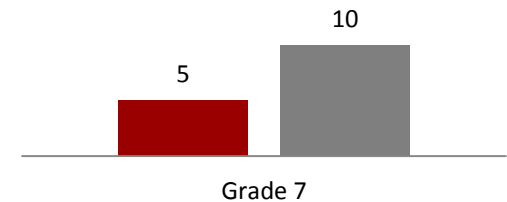

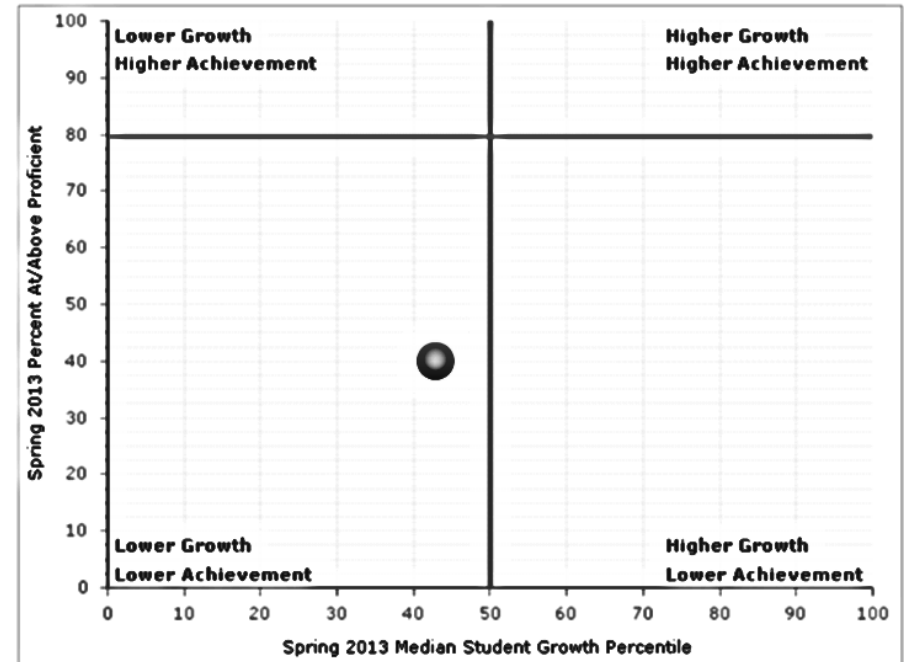
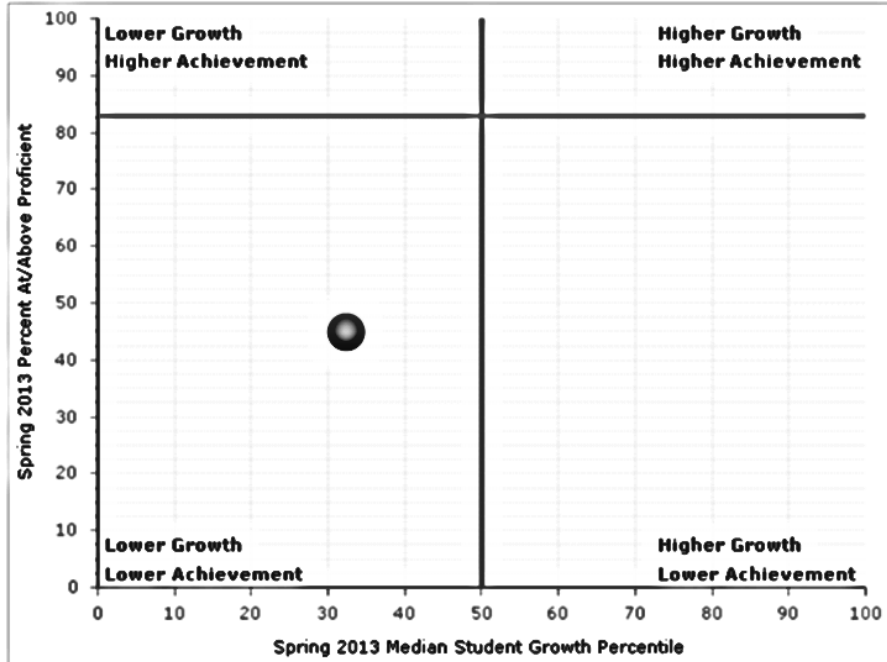
