Completion Rate and Job Placement:

Grace Theological Seminary desires that students graduate in a timely way and are competent to perform the skills that are part of effective ministry in order to be ambassadors in the world for God's great love.

Current students and graduates of Grace Theological Seminary report great satisfaction with their ability to schedule classes and work with academic advisors in order to complete their degree in a timely way. Sixty-four percent of respondents were employed within six months of graduating from Grace Theological Seminary (35% were employed for the first time in church related positions). A smaller portion of our students (17%) indicated that they are pursuing foreign missions.
