Students participating in the Department of Defense (DOD) Tuition Assistance (TA) program will have the following reimbursement rate accompany other reimbursement policies. However, this is specifically for the DOD TA program and its funds only. Service refers to the branch of government that is hosting the service member's TA funding (e.g. U.S. Navy, National Guard, etc.).

Undergraduate:

Grace College traditional undergraduate students receiving funds from the Department of Defense Tuition Assistance program will have Tuition Assistance funds reimbursed to the Service at a rate of 5% from week 5 through week 10.

Grace College GOAL students receiving funds from the Department of Defense Tuition Assistance program will have Tuition Assistance funds reimbursed to the Service at a rate of 5% from week 7 through week 10.

Graduate/Seminary:

Grace College Masters/Doctorate students receiving funds from the Department of Defense Tuition Assistance program will have Tuition Assistance funds reimbursed to the Service at a rate of 5% from week 3 through week 5.

Grace College MDQM Master's/ORCA students receiving funds from the Department of Defense Tuition Assistance program will have Tuition Assistance funds reimbursed to the Service at a rate of 5% from the point where the overall reimbursement rate goes to 0% through 60% of the course.
