Completion Rate and Job Placement:

Grace Seminary is committed to helping students graduate in a timely way. Each student is assigned an academic advisor who provides assistance in planning the student's academic route. The academic advisor is also committed to discussing career plans that might be of interest to the

student. Grace faculty members are dedicated to helping students become competent to perform the skills that are part of effective ministry in order to be ambassadors in the world for God's great love.

Current students and graduates of Grace Theological Seminary report great satisfaction with their ability to schedule classes and work with academic advisors in order to complete their degree in a timely way. Ninety-two percent of students surveyed completed their degree in the amount of time designated as normal. Eighty-three percent of graduates were employed within six months of graduating.
