  - E. Assist with network and telephone moves adds and changes
2. Network maintenance and troubleshooting
  - A. Install and/or maintain physical connections to users.
  - B. Assist with cabling and infrastructure projects that are not outsourced.
  - C. Troubleshoot data and voice network connectivity issues.
3. Information security
  - A. Assist with network and endpoint security design recommendations
  - B. Schedule and perform systems scanning and remediation efforts
4. Collaborate on daily operations with other OIT staff members and contribute to departmental long range planning efforts.
5. Conduct user training consistent with departmental philosophy and goals.
6. Perform other departmental assistance as directed by supervisor.

2. One to two years' experience of PC hardware and software maintenance/support.
3. Detailed knowledge of Microsoft Windows platform and MS-Office suite.
