

Policy: Academic Honors Effective: June 1, 2019 Policy Type: Faculty <u>Responsible Department: Registrar Office</u>

Policy: Students are awarded academic honors based on GPA requirements specified for each academic program and if they have completed at least half their degree credits at Grace College and/or Theological Seminary.

- 1.0 Degree-completion, graduate, and seminary programs are awarded honors with GPAs of 3.75 of higher on a 4.0 scale are designated as *Honors Graduates*.
- 2.0 Students in the adult degree completion programs are awarded honors based on all of the required credit hours of course work completed at Grace College and any elective credits taken at Grace College after the student entered the GOAL Program.
- 3.0 Seminary students in the Deploy competency-based programs are awarded honors when they complete their program with no more than one Proficiency Completion grade.
- 4.0 Students in traditional undergraduate programs receive honors using the following categories: *Cum laude* 3.650 - 3.799 *Magna cum laude* 3.800 - 3.939 *Summa cum laude* 3.940 - 4.000
- 5.0 Associate degree students are awarded honors with GPAs of 3.65 of higher on a scaled of 4.0 are designated *Honors Graduates.*
- 6.0 Upon receipt and posting of the final grades for the last term attended, the final GPA is recorded.
- 7.0 Any grade adjustments upward that may earn more advanced honors than were publicly announced or any grade adjustments downward that might officially remove honors from the student will be so noted on the permanent transcript.
- 8.0 Honors cords are distributed based on the student's GPA at the time of Commencement. Honors cords are distributed only at Commencement, and are not provided to graduates not participating at Commencement.
