Field Trip Options



Research and Writing Option

Geared toward high school students, these field trips focus on primary documents, including written and physical artifacts. After an explanation and presentation of these primary documents, the students have a tour of the museum and then complete a brief writing assignment.



Social Studies Option

Focusing on students from grade 3 to 12, these field trips cover various historical objectives as chosen by the accompanying teacher.
