Grace College invites applications and nominations for an **instructor position in the physical sciences**. Responsibilities include teaching and conducting laboratories based on department needs and enrollment demands.

A successful applicant will display a strong commitment to liberal arts undergraduate education which includes supporting the Department's contribution to Grace's CORE, the Faith, Science, and Reason course. Also, the candidate must continually identify opportunities to integrate faith within classroom instruction in a manner that encourages spiritual growth while also complementing course content. Finally, a successful candidate will have a contemporary understanding of physical science topics based on recent findings and current publications.

<u>Qualifications:</u> This position offers the opportunity to become an adjunct faculty member with the ability to grow professionally under the mentorship of department leads. Position qualifications include:

- a PhD in a physical science discipline (preferred); or, a Master's degree with 18 graduate credits in a physical science
- strong communication skills with a disposition that positively reflects their Christian faith
- a student-centered approach to teaching that blends both active and didactic forms of instruction
- a desire to integrate faith with learning in the classroom; and,
- a willingness to collaborate with colleagues in a constructive manner
