



DECLARATION OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students who cannot provide proof of financial ability through any of the documents listed below must complete this form and provide documentation as required. For students who need an F-1 visa to study in the United States, Grace College is required by U.S. Government regulations to check the availability of adequate funding for their tuition, fees, and living expenses for the duration of their studies. Until all funding documentation has been completed and returned to the Office of Admissions & the Institute for Global Studies, we will be unable to provide a student with a Certificate of Eligibility (I-20) to apply for an F-1 student visa. Students should keep copies of this completed form and supporting documentation for presentation to the U.S. Consulate when requesting a student visa and to immigration officials when entering the United States. Students must inform P/DSO if they plan on bringing dependent(s), & dependent(s) must also apply for an F-2 visa to accompany them to the United States.
