



Policy: Major and Minor Credit Limits
Effective: June 1, 2020
Policy Type: Faculty/Regulatory
Responsible Department: Registrar

Policy: This policy sets the minimum credit requirements for degree programs, majors, and minors.

- 1.0 Associate Degree Programs have a minimum requirement of 60 credit hours.
- 2.0 Bachelor Degree Programs have a minimum requirement of 120 credit hours.
 - 2.1 Undergraduate majors must have at least 39 credit hours related to the major.
 - 2.2 Undergraduate minors are required to have at least 18 credit hours.
- 3.0 Undergraduate students that desire to earn a second major must complete at least 21 distinct credit hours for the second major. When both majors are from the same school or department within a school, that school or department may elect to not offer double majors due to limited program offerings, or require a higher number of unique credits; this would be reflected on the course catalog for that school/department.
- 4.0 Undergraduate students desiring a minor must complete at least 15 distinct credit hours to earn the minor. When both major and minor are from the same school or department within a school, that school or department may elect to specify courses counting toward major vs minor; this will be reflected in the course catalog or the degree checksheet.
- 5.0 Graduate Degrees have a minimum requirement of 30 credit hours.
