To be eligible to participate in a Transition to Teaching program in secondary education within the state of Indiana, applicants must meet <u>one</u> of these four conditions:

1. Bachelor's degree in subject area or related field in which thecandidate wants to teach and an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher from accredited institution 1. Bachelor's degree in subject area or related field in which the candidate wants to teach with 2.5 GPA from accredited institution

2. 5 years of <u>relevant</u> professional experience

1. Bachelor's degree from accredited institution

2. Proof of passing state approved secondary content area assessment in the subject area the candidate wants to teach
