Grace College invites applications for the position of Instructor of Modern Languages (Spanish), to begin fall 2026. We seek an expert in Spanish who has broad teaching interests in language and culture. who demonstrates excellence in language instruction, has a deep understanding of Spanish culture and language, and pursues meaningful integration of Christian faith within the liberal arts. The ideal candidate will have cross-cultural expertise in areas of the following: Spanish and/or Latin American studies, intercultural communication, and interdisciplinary approaches to Spanish language and literature. Competencies will include cultural intelligence, teaching, advising, curriculum development, and professional growth.

- A strong commitment to the mission and values of the institution, including the integration of faith and learning
